The Presidential Scholarship is designed to attract academically superior students to Kilgore College.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

- 1. To be eligible to apply, high school seniors must meet at least two of the following three criteria.
 - A. ACT-- (prior to February 15, 2023): composite score of 25 with a minimum of 19 on English. and/or a minimum of 19 on mathematics test. (On or after February 15, 2023) combined score of 45 on English and Reading (E+R). A score of 25 on mathematics. There is no composite score.
 - SAT-- Minimum score of 650 in evidence-based reading and writing and 620 in math.
 - B. High School grade average of 92 or higher.
 - C. Must be ranked in top 10 percent of graduating class.
- 2. Deadline for applying for the scholarship is March 1st of each year.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE AND CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY The Kilgore College Scholarship Committee will review, evaluate, select and mail notifications to recipients no later than April 1.

Recipients must notify the committee, in writing, by May 1 of their intention to accept the scholarship. Presidential Scholarship provides tuition, fees and use of books. Accepting this scholarship also create the following obligations on the part of the student:

- 1. Awards are made for one (1) semester, with a review at the end of each semester. Recipients must maintain a 3.3 Cumulative GPA with a minimum course load of 15 hours per semester.
- 2. Recipients must attend a function hosted by the President of Kilgore College each fall and serve 12 hours a semester as a representative of Kilgore College.
- 3. Each recipient must exhibit satisfactory personal conduct as outlined in the KC Student Handbook.
- 4. Recipients of this award may accept other Kilgore College institutional scholarships to cover the cost of room and board in college housing. They may accept scholarships from other sources.
- 5. Recipients may request approval for up to two additional long semesters of this scholarship.

Scholarships are based upon academic performance and require that the student meet the requirements as listed. Not more than sixty (60 percent) of the courses in a student's semester schedule shall be in a single discipline. Scholarship renewals and applications require that the student comply with the conditions of the agreement and that satisfactory progress be demonstrated toward earning a degree or certificate.

The scholarship covers two long semesters (fall and spring). Any exception to this policy must be approved by the Kilgore College Scholarship Committee. Should the student withdraw from school or drop below the minimum class load, the scholarship will be recovered through any refunds due the student.
