The Kilgore College Steel Band

KC Steel at Kilgore College is a performing group that learns and performs traditional Trinidadian music as well as Classical, Rock, Jazz, and World Music styled arrangements. A large focus for the group is the annual performances with national and international guest artists in the Caribbean music community. Students learn all aspects of steel drumming, music reading and improvisation, and stylistic interpretations for an exciting multi-cultural musical experience.



Derrick Logozzo is an active performer, educator, author, consultant, and conductor based in Dallas, TX. He performs regularly throughout the US on steel drums and percussion with his Caribbean Jazz Group, *Kalimbe*, as well as with various commercial recording artists and symphony orchestras. Derrick also manages and performs in his jazz group, *New Vibe*, and world percussion group, *DrumArt*. He is also principal percussionist with the Irving Symphony Orchestra in Dallas, TX. Performance credits include concerts with the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, the Ft. Worth Symphony Orchestra, Carlos Guedes, Sandi Patti, Airto Moreira, Dave Samuels, Sandi Duncan, Steve Gadd, Poncho Sanchez, Joe McBride, Steve Amerson, Michael Martin Murphy, and Monica Mancini.

As for education, Derrick currently serves as Department Chair of Music and Dance and Director of Bands and Instrumental Music at Kilgore College in Kilgore, Texas. There, he conducts the Wind Symphony, Jazz Ensemble, Steel Band, and Athletic Bands as well as teaches Applied Percussion, Drum Set, Conducting, and Jazz Studies. He was recently Department Chair of Music and Director of Instrumental Music Studies at Richland College in Dallas, TX, for 13 years where he conducted the Richland Wind Symphony, Big Band Jazz Ensemble, Percussion Group, and Steel Bands, and taught percussion, drum set, and conducting studies and was awarded Associate Faculty of the Year and twice nominated for Administrator of the Year. While at Richland, he helped facilitate the earning of national accreditation from the National Association of Schools of Music for the Music Department overseeing over 30 faculty and 500 students and facilitating over \$1.5 million in equipment and facility improvements. Derrick has also been a faculty member at The University of North Texas, Texas Wesleyan University, Tarrant County College, Eastfield College, Centennial High School (Frisco, TX) and Duncanville, TX schools.

Derrick also manages and writes for his music firm, *Derrickmusic*, where his bands, publications and recordings are commercially available. He is the author of the chapter, *Marching Percussion History*, for The Encyclopedia of Percussion, (Routledge Publishing) as well as the resource book, Percussion (Kjos Publishing). He has most recently produced a series of natural drumming technique videos for Michael Udow's Percussion Pedagogy method resource available through Oxford University Press.
