The student will learn principles of medical coding related to the three main code books: CPT®, ICD-10-CM Code Set and HCPCS Level II. This course is recommended for anyone who is preparing for a career in medical coding for a physician's office and strongly recommended for anyone who is preparing for AAPC's CPC certification examination. This course assures a broad knowledge in reviewing and assigning the correct procedure and diagnosis codes for professional (physician) services. Upon completion of the course student will be able to sit for certification exam with AAPC, certification exam is included with tuition.
